

2017 KENNETT HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL

PROGRAM INFORMATION

PROGRAM OFFERINGS The 2017 Kennett School District Summer School Program will be limited to only Kennett High School students who are currently enrolled in grades 9-12 who need to recover semester credit in a course in one of the four core curriculum areas of Communication Arts, Math, Science, or Social Studies **AND** students who are currently enrolled in grades 8-11 who wish to take either PE (with embedded Health Credit) which will be offered as a full day, 1 credit unit, pass/fail course or Personal Finance (grades 10-12 only) which will be offered as half-day, 1/2 credit unit, pass/fail courses.

PROGRAM DATES AND LOCATION Monday, May 22, 2017 through Tuesday, June 20, 2017. The Kennett School District Summer School Program for KHS students will begin on Monday, May 22, 2017 at 8:00 a.m. and end on Tuesday, June 20, 2017 at 2:30 p.m. Summer School will NOT be in session on Friday, May 26, 2017 and Monday, May 29, 2017 in observance of the Memorial Day holiday.

TIME 8:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. Students are to arrive on campus at 8:00 a.m. and report to the cafeteria. Students are not to be on campus prior to 7:45 a.m.

MATERIALS All students should bring a pencil/pen and paper with them on the first day of the Summer School Program. All other materials will be provided.

TRANSPORTATION **Bus transportation will be provided.**

BREAKFAST / LUNCH Breakfast (8:00 a.m.) and Lunch (11:30 a.m.) will be provided at no cost to the student.

ATTENDANCE INCENTIVE There will be NO monetary attendance incentive for the Summer School Program.

ATTENDANCE POLICY Students who attend Summer School to recover credit are required to be in attendance each day from 8:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. If a student completes his/her assigned credit recovery program and successfully demonstrates mastery of the course content on the exit exam, the student may be released from the Summer School Program prior to June 22, 2015. For students attending summer school to earn 1 credit unit in PE (with embedded Health credit), the student must attend the required 120 clock hours or 20 full attendance days to earn the 1 credit unit. For students attending summer school to earn ½ credit unit in Personal Finance, 60 clock hours or 20 one-half day attendance days are required to earn the ½ credit unit.

Students who attend Summer School to recover credit due to violation of the attendance policy the previous semester will be required to attend the number of days as determined by their attendance contract.

Parents will be notified by phone and/or e-mail of any student absence during the Kennett School District Summer School Program, provided current and accurate contact information has been submitted on the enrollment form.
